Also contemporary art can be admired in Kampen. Kampen is in fact home to many exhibition spaces and appealing art initiatives such as the ‘Artist Prize Kampen ‘ and the annual ‘Art Route’, ‘Weg van Kunst’.

This booklet shows you the way along all of these sculptures. On this inspiring route you can enjoy a wide range of works of art in parks and districts. 43 sculptures illustrate the story of Kampen throughout the years. ‘The Schokkermonument’ for example, which I find a fascinating sculpture, takes me back to the time when the ‘Schokkers’ (the inhabitants of the island Schokland) had to leave their island in 1859 and settled in Brunnepe. The couple is looking, while disembarking a vessel, in the direction of Brunnepe, their new, uncertain future. This event is a vital link in the history of Kampen. Art is blood running through the veins of society. Over the next few years there will be a further increase in the range of sculptures. Iron characters.**

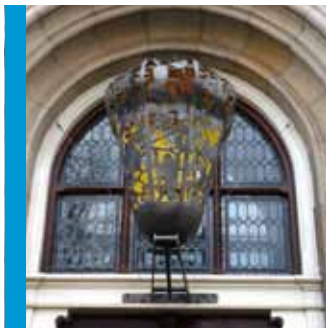
35 words spread over a length of 1400 meters on the embankment of the Vloeddijk. These words relate to the history of the houses located behind the embankment on the Vloeddijk.

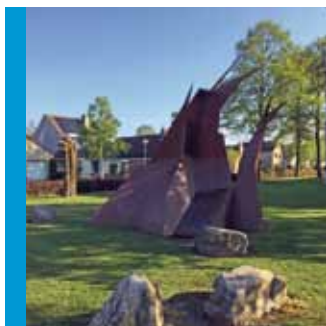

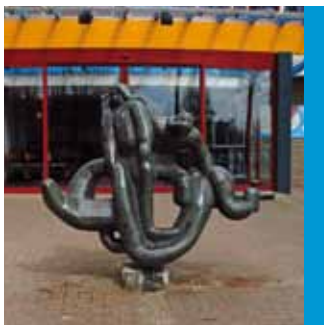

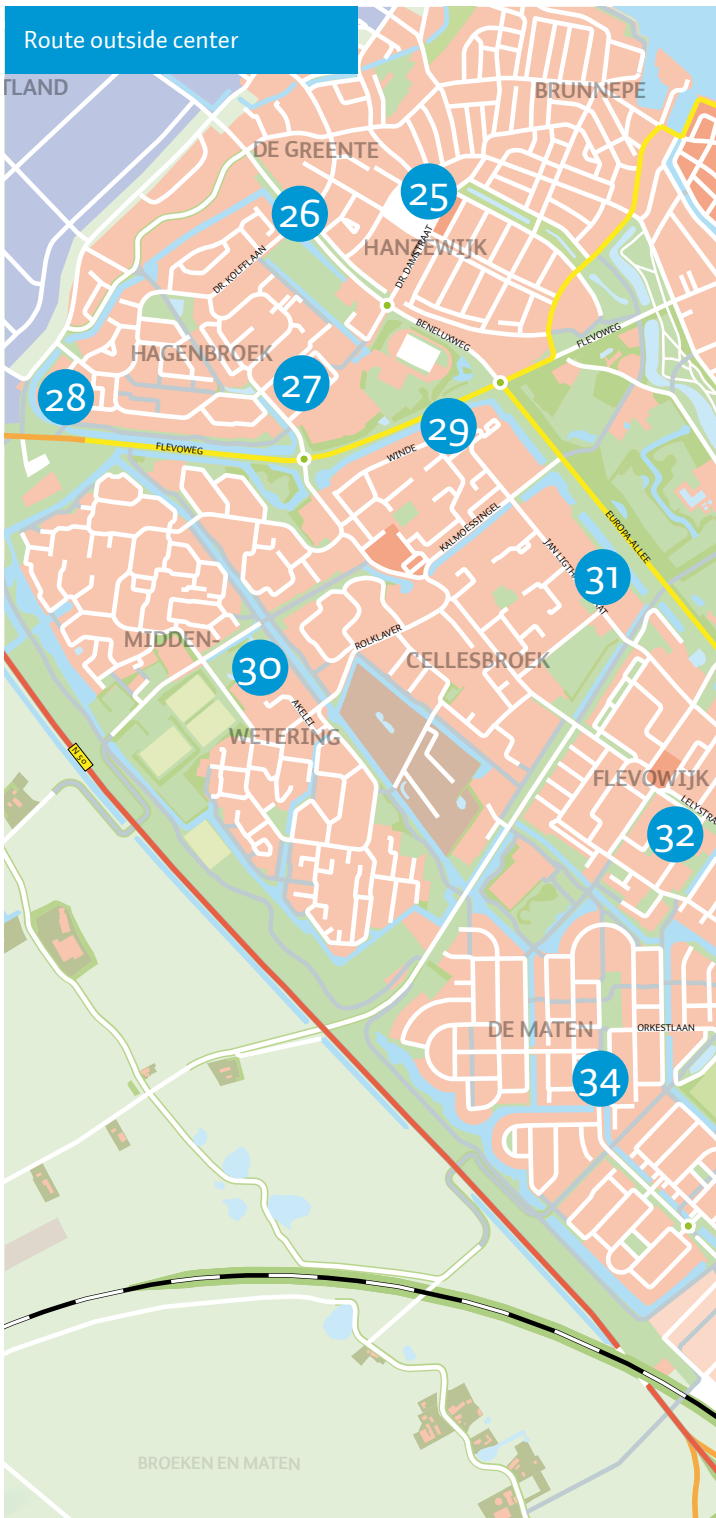
